

Multi-point Function operating: (B301 can be paired with two phones)

Pairing the B301 headset with the first phone

1. Press and hold the MFB button on the top of the headset until the indicator light flashes blue and red alternately.
2. Set the phone to search button for Bluetooth device. Refer to your phone manual for details of how to do this.
3. Phone displays "B301 "; select it from the list.
4. If prompted for a code by your phone, enter the pass code "0000".
5. If the pairing is successful, the indicator light will flash blue twice; some phones may require the user to make the connection separately after pairing. Please see the user guide for your phone for more details.
6. Repeat steps 1-4 if the pairing was unsuccessful. You only need to pair to a device once but you may need to pair again if you have paired the B301 headset to an alternative device.

Pairing the B301 headset with a second phone

1. After successful connecting the first phone, please switch off the headset and repeat the above steps to connect the second phone.
2. When the second phone is connected, please switch off the headset again.
3. Switching on the headset again will automatically connect these two phones.
4. Now you can use it to answer/end a call from either of these phones.

Disconnecting the headset from the phone.

1. Press the MFB key once (a tone will be heard) to switch off the B301 headset, it will then disconnect from your phone.
2. Disconnect the headset in the Bluetooth menu of your phone. Please refer to your phone's user manual for how to do this. Note: You do not need to delete the Bluetooth headset from your phone's Bluetooth device list if you want to reconnect B301 with your phone.
3. Move the headset at least 32 feet (10 meters) away from the phone not more than that or else connection will lost.

To reconnect a paired headset with your phone

Long press the MFB button once to reconnect your B301 headset to your phone.

Storing your headset:

1. Power off the headset.
2. Keep in a temperature range of :-10°C/14°F--60°C/140°F
3. Do not expose the headset to rain or liquids.
4. In order to prolong the battery and charger, please charge and discharge the headset once a week when you don't use it for a long time.
5. Please fully charged the Bluetooth Headset when you use it for the first time.

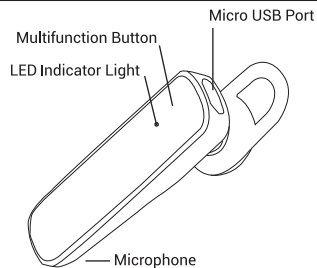
Bluetooth Headset Users Guide



B301 STEREO MUSIC HEADSET

Includes:

1. Multifunction Button
2. LED Indicator Light
3. Microphone
4. Micro USB Port



1. Introduction Charging the Headset

Before using for the first time, the B301 headset should be fully charged using the supplied charging cable.

1. Connect the small connector on the AC charging cable to the headset.
2. Plug the AC connector into the wall.
3. The headset's red LED light will display during charging.
4. When charging is complete, the red LED will turn blue.
5. You can now disconnect the headset and cable from the AC power.

A complete charge will take approx. 2-3 hours

Operating the Headset

Power On: Long press the MFB button, the blue light will flash 3 times and audio reminder will prompt saying power on, the battery status and ready to connect.

Power Off: Long press the MFB button, the red light will flash 3 times with audio reminder power off.

Pairing: Long press the MFB button, the blue light will flash 3 times and audio reminder will prompt power on, battery status and device connected.

Pairing Successful: The blue light will flash 2 times

Bluetooth connecting and searching status: When being turned on but not successful connected yet, the red and blue lights will flash together continuously until the connection is successful.

Pairing Failed: The red light will flash 5 times quickly.

Standby Mode Unpaired: The blue light quickly flashes; the headset will power off automatically if it is not paired within 5 minutes.

Standby Mode Paired: The blue light flashes.

Incoming Call: Audio reminder prompt incoming call with telephone number

Answering Incoming Call: Press the MFB button once, the blue light quickly flashes.

End Call: Press the MFB button once and prompt call disconnected.

Reject Incoming Call: Long Press MFB button for 2 seconds and release it.

Re-Dial last called Number: In standby mode, double-click the MFB button, will redial the last dialed number.

Low Battery Warning: When battery is low, it will remind as "Low battery" by voice and the playing music will shut down.

Headset is disconnected: The red light will keep flashing until the headset is run out of battery and turned off.

Pause Playing: When playing music by using Bluetooth headset, short press the MFB button to pause the music and to resume back again short press the MFB button

Transfer Talking:

From headset to mobile: while talking press the MFB button for 1 second or long press until the tone is heard and says call disconnected. Repeat the above procedure to go on talking with the Bluetooth headset. From mobile phone to headset: while talking press the MFB button for 1-2 seconds or long press until the tone is heard
