






| <p>For user safety, please read this manual in its entirety before using the headset.</p> <p>The following matters should paid close attention to when using the headphones:</p> <p>Please avoid using the high volume mode because it may lead to hearing loss due to excessive noise.</p> <p>If you are in a potentially dangerous situation, please stop using the headphones to ensure your safety.</p> <p>Users should exhibit reasonableness in controlling the volume and in listening time when using the headphones.</p> <p>The volume should not be so high that it prevents your from hearing voices around you. If the volume is set too high, a condition known as tinnitus (ringing in the ears) may set in. If you experience any such sensations, please love the volume to prevent permanent hearing loss.</p> <p>We do not recommend listening to music while driving.</p> <p>To clean the LTwins headset, use a dry soft cloth only. The use of water should be avoided. Submersion of the headphones into liquid will damage the headset.</p> <p>If you experience any obvious discomfort, unwanted sensations or other adverse reactions while using the headset, stop using them immediately.</p> <p>The headphones should not be stored or used in temperatures below 15° C (5° F) or higher than 55° C (131° F). Operating outside of this temperature range will reduce the life of the headphones and/or the battery.</p> | <p>Charging the headset and box:</p> <p>Before charging the headset and charging box, please check that the charging cable you're using is the original one.</p> <p>LTwins has an internal, rechargeable battery which must be fully charged before used for the first time. It takes you about 2-3 hours to charge the battery full for the first time.</p>  <p>First of all, remove insulated sheet from charging tips</p> <p>A. Put the headsets into the charging box and close the box to charge. During charging, the indicator shows a steady red. When the battery is fully charged, the red light will turn off.</p> <p>B. You can charge the charging box either by using the AC travel charger, USB charging cable or the car charger. When the charging box is fully charged, all of the four LED lights will turn blue.</p>  <p>The fully charged battery has power for up to 3-4 hours of talking time or up to 100 hours of standby time.</p> <p>When the battery is running out of power, the red indicator light starts to flash every 20 seconds with prompt of "low battery, please charge.". This indicates that the headset needs to be charged as soon as possible.</p> <p>Battery status of the charging box: click on the button on the charging box, you will see the battery status through the four blue LED. And the display will turn off automatically after 4 seconds.</p> | <p>Functional operation</p> <p>1) Switch on or off the headset</p> <p>To switch on, when LTwins is in off state, press and hold the answer/end key for 3 seconds until the blue indicator light starts to flash for 3 times with prompt of "power on".</p> <p>To switch off, when LTwins is in on state, press and hold the answer/end key for 3 seconds until the red indicator light flashes for 3 times with prompt of "power off".</p> <p>2) Pair and connect the headset with a compatible phone:</p> <p>LTwins Pairing: When the LTwins are in off state, press and hold the answer/end key of both headsets for 7 seconds until the blue and red light flash alternatively, now they will pair and connect automatically with prompt "connected, left channel, right channel, get into pairing mode".</p> <p>A. After LTwins connecting successfully, the blue and red light of left (main) headset flash alternatively with prompt of pairing, which means the pair of headsets are now in pairing mode.</p> <p>B. Once the Bluetooth connection between headset and mobile phone is disconnected by hand, the headset will get into pairing mode automatically.</p> <p>Pairing is the process of establishing link between LTwins and Bluetooth devices. If no pairing is made over 5 minutes, the headset will retreat pairing mode.</p> | <p>Step-1) The headset must be powered off before you begin to initiate the pairing.</p> <p>Step-2) Press and hold the answer/end key for 7 seconds until the blue and red light flash alternatively. The headset is now in pairing mode.</p> <p>Step-3) Activate the Bluetooth feature on the phone, and set the phone to search for Bluetooth devices. Check the user guide of your phone for instructions.</p> <p>Step-4) Select the headset (LTwins) from the list of found devices.</p> <p>When you open the Bluetooth function on mobile phone, you will find two LTwins on the list of found devices. After a while, it will be one only, then choose LTwins and connect it with Bluetooth mobile phone.</p> <p>Step-5) when asked the PIN code, please enter "0000" to pair and connect the headset to your phone. In some phones you may need to make the connection separately after pairing. See the user guide of your phone for details.</p> <p>If the pairing is successful, the headset enters idle state and blue light will flash 1 time every 7 seconds. Connect the headset and mobile phone, and you will hear "pairing successful, connected". The headset's name appears in the phone menu where you can view the currently paired Bluetooth devices.</p> <p>If no Bluetooth connection is made within 10 minutes, the headset will turn off automatically.</p> <p>Troubleshooting</p> <p>If you cannot connect the headset to your phone, do as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ensure that the headset is charged, switched on, paired with and connected to your phone. Ensure that the Bluetooth feature is activated on your phone. Check that the headset is within 10 meter (30 feet) of your phone and that there are no obstructions between the headset and the phone, such as walls or other electronic devices. <p>3) Auto reconnection</p> <p>When the two LTwins are in off state, switch them on at the same time, they will reconnect automatically. And the left (main) headset will reconnect to the paired mobile phone automatically too.</p> |  <p>Note: If both the headsets have been paired, then for the call function only the left side is going to work however if the headsets are being used separately i.e. either right or left side, the call function will work respectively.</p> <p>Product pictured in this manual is for demonstration purposes only. | <p>4) Basic use</p> <p>-Make a call</p> <p>To make a call, use your phone in the normal way when the headset is connected to your phone. Make two Bluetooth enable devices to be in wireless connection. It will be automatically distinguished between left channel and right channel headsets.</p> <p>Note: If both the headsets have been paired, then for the call function only the left side is going to work however if the headsets are being used separately i.e. either right or left side, the call function will work respectively.</p> <p>After LTwins connecting, you can play/pause music through either of the two headsets, but only left (main) headset has call function.</p> <p>When the LTwins headsets are in on state, press and hold answer/end key of either headset for 3 second to power off both headsets.
